


NOTICE TO INVESTORS

Mexico City, February 10, 2020 – BRASKEM IDESA S.A.P.I (SGX: BAKIDE), comes herein to announce to the market and its investors that the company has reached an important milestone with the importing of its first shipment of ethane, which will be used as feedstock to produce polyethylene at its Petrochemical Complex in Mexico.

With an approximate investment of US\$4 million, this complementary solution for acquiring feedstock will make it possible to import up to 12,800 barrels per day of ethane to the Petrochemical Complex in Mexico, which represents 19% of its ethane needs.

The imported Ethane will be shipped from ethane export terminals in the United States via specialized vessels and then offloaded to cryogenic tanks at Coatzacoalcos Port, where is subsequently transferred via filling stations to cryogenic isocontainers trucks and transported to Braskem Idesa's complex to be unloaded into existing ethane storage tanks.
