

## NOTICE TO INVESTORS

**Mexico City, January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – BRASKEM IDESA S.A.P.I. (SGX: BAKIDE)**

To maintain its shareholders and the market informed and following up with the notice dated December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, Braskem Idesa ("BI") announces that it has partially resumed its operating activities based on an experimental business model, following the applicable safety standards, to reduce the impact on the Mexican plastic industry's supply chain.

Braskem Idesa further informs that legal measures have been initiated to enforce its legal and contractual rights, as established in the Ethane Supply Agreement entered into between BI and PEMEX. Braskem Netherlands B.V., BI's direct shareholder, also initiated legal measures based on applicable international rules to enforce its legal and contractual rights to protect its investment in Mexico. Such measures include a remediation and negotiation period during which it will seek a resolution between the parties.

Braskem Idesa remains subject to an adverse scenario due to the interruption of the natural gas transportation and cannot estimate, at this moment, the date for the full return of BI activities or the impact of the disruption of such activities.

Braskem Idesa reinforces its commitment to the pursuit of constructive alternatives to resolve the country's ethane shortage. The Company will keep Investors informed of any developments relating to this matter.
